The role of Academic Standards lead is to Chair the Academic forum

The setting of standards of practice and conduct, education and training in a consistent and rigorous manner. This would include dealing with the accreditation of institutions who provide appropriate education for healthcare chaplains as well as all matters relating to continuing professional development (CPD). This work is supported by an academic advisor and the academic forum which comprises all the academic institutions providing chaplaincy education.

Essential values and knowledge that are important for this role

- Doctoral Studies in a subject relevant to Healthcare Chaplaincy
- An awareness of the programmes in the UK and beyond by which candidates train to be healthcare chaplains.
- Experience of Chairing meetings
- Experience of leadership in healthcare chaplaincy
- Open-mindedness, yet with a clear vision
- Respect for others regardless of background or views
- Service of others
- Good listening and communication skills
- Organisational knowledge of the role and workings of UKBHC
- Good planning and organisational skills
- Honesty and integrity
- Harmony
- An interview panel may be set up to shortlist and then to interview. The panel will normally consist of three designated Board members
- Please note, there must be two referees supporting the expression of interest, who can confirm suitability and capability for the role
- This is a voluntary role, but reasonable expenses can be claimed for attendance at meetings or other necessary agreed UKBHC expenses
